

## **BVP Mystery Quilt – March 2010**

**March is another easy month. We're going to take the 4-patch units you made in November (Units One and Two) and combine them with the units you made in December (Units 3, 4, 5 and 6), along with the remaining Fabric A rectangles. Here again, pay attention to color placement. You will wind up with a total of 10 blocks—5 each of two color combinations.**

- 1. Take your Unit One 4-patches and add the  $6\frac{1}{2}''\times 3\frac{1}{2}''$  ( $4\frac{3}{4}''\times 2\frac{3}{4}''$ ) ( $3\frac{1}{2}''\times 2''$ ) Fabric A rectangles to each side of the Unit.**
- 2. Sew Unit 3 to the top of the Unit One block.**
- 3. Sew Unit 4 to the bottom of your Unit One block.**
- 4. Make 5 blocks using this color combination.**
- 5. Take the remaining  $6\frac{1}{2}''\times 3\frac{1}{2}''$  ( $4\frac{3}{4}''\times 2\frac{3}{4}''$ ) ( $3\frac{1}{2}''\times 2''$ ) Fabric A rectangles and add them to each side of the Unit Two four-patches.**
- 6. Sew the Unit 5 pieces to the top of your Unit Two 4-patches.**
- 7. Sew Unit 6 pieces to the bottom of your Unit Two 4-patches.**
- 8. Makes 5 blocks using this color combination.**

**That's it—you now have 10 blocks ready for next month when we'll put the top together. Then in May you can either catch up or add additional borders if you want.**
