WORKSHOP

Mary Neitzel is originally from Chicago and moved to Pennsylvania about 20 years ago. Mary has been quilting for about 22 years and is a member of the North Pittsburgh Quilters Guild where she has served as President and has been involved with their quilt shows, coordinating the judging event and raffle quilt. Mary was one of the original organizers of the Camp Kon-O-Kwee Quilter's Retreat held in January – now in its 18th year. She has organized the creation of a raffle quilt to benefit the Mercer County Habitat for Humanity organization. Currently Mary is a member of the Where The Corners Meet Quilt Guild in New Wilmington, PA, and the Northwest Pennsylvania Quilt Study Group in Meadville, PA.

You may have seen Mary at The Quilting Bee in New Wilmington, PA, where she has been employed for the last 4 years; and taught many classes in paper piecing, scrap quilts and Civil War Reproduction quilts. Mary is also a long arm quilter.

Mary enters her quilts in many of local shows including our show, and over the years has won several ribbons. Mary's main interest in quilting is scrap quilts and Civil War Reproduction quilts which will be evident in the fun classes she has planned just for us!
