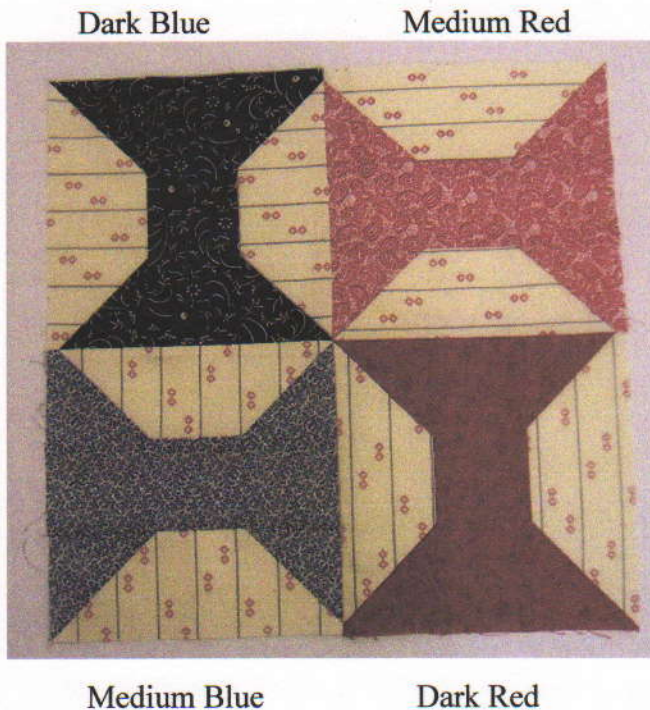


Block Lotto October 2008

Spools



Background - Shirting
Color 1 - Dark Blue
Color 2 - Medium Blue
Color 3 - Dark Red
Color 4 - Medium Red

Background cut 8 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Color 1, 2, 3, 4 - cut 1 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for the middle

Color 1, 2, 3, 4 - cut 4 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square for the side units

To make the side units, place the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square right sides together on top the left and right ends of the background rectangle, with outer edges aligned. On the back of the squares lightly mark the diagonal. Sew ON this diagonal marking. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press the seam allowance towards the triangle. They should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Sew the background with color unit to the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for the middle (same color as the side units) using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Press seams to the center.

Sew the 4 blocks together as in the above picture.
