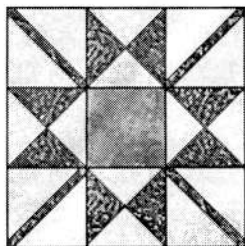


January Block 2009

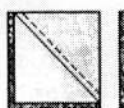
12" Old Snowflake Block



Cutting instructions

- 1 - 4 ½" square center fabric – medium blue
- 2 - 5 ½" squares darker shade of blue
- 2 - 5 ½" squares white on white
- 4 - 1" x 7 ¼" rectangles darker shade of blue
- 4 - 5" squares white on white fabric

Place 5 ½" white and 5 ½" dark square right sides together. (press)
This helps them to stay together.



Draw a diagonal line from lower left corner to upper right corner

Sew ¼" on both sides of the drawn line



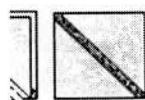
Cut apart diagonally from each of the corners.

Press seam allowance to the darker side.



Match the pairs so that the blues are opposite.
Sew the two halves together and square to 4 ½".

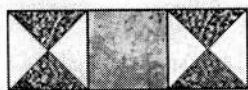
Cut on the diagonal the white on white 5" squares to make 8 half square triangles.



Sew the 1" x 7 ¼" rectangle to each side of the half square white on white. Press seam toward the light fabric. Repeat until all 4 corners are done.



Using diagram, assemble like a nine patch.



This should measure 12 ½" now.
