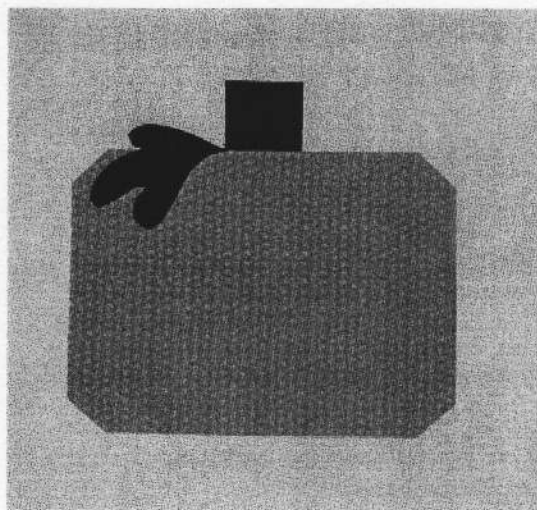


# Block Lotto November 2008



Tan Background	2 - 4 ½ x 4 ½
	2 - 2 ½ x 14 ½
	1 - 2 ½ x 10 ½
	1 - 2 ½ x 2 ½
	4 - 1 ½ x 1 ½
Brown Stem	1 - 2 ½ x 2 ½
Orange Pumpkin	1 - 8 ½ x 10 ½
Green Leaf	1 - 3 ½ x 3 ¾

Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 ½" squares

Align the 1 ½" square with one corner of the orange rectangle. Sew on drawn line, trim excess leaving ¼" seam allowance. Repeat for the remaining 3 corners

Press the triangles open and the rectangle should measure 8 ½ x 10 ½.

Sew a brown 2 ½" square to a tan 2 ½" square.

Sew a tan 4 ½ x 4 ½ square to each side of the brown and tan unit making the stem unit..

Sew the stem unit to the pumpkin unit. Press seam.

Sew 2 ½ x 10 ½ rectangle to bottom. Press seam.

Sew 2 ½ x 14 ½ rectangle to each side. Press seams.

The block should measure 14 ½ inches square.

Using your favorite method of appliqué attach the leaf to either side of the stem.

The template is drawn for fusible web and appliquéd to the right side. If you are going to put it on the left remember to reverse the leaf. (It is pictured on the left)
