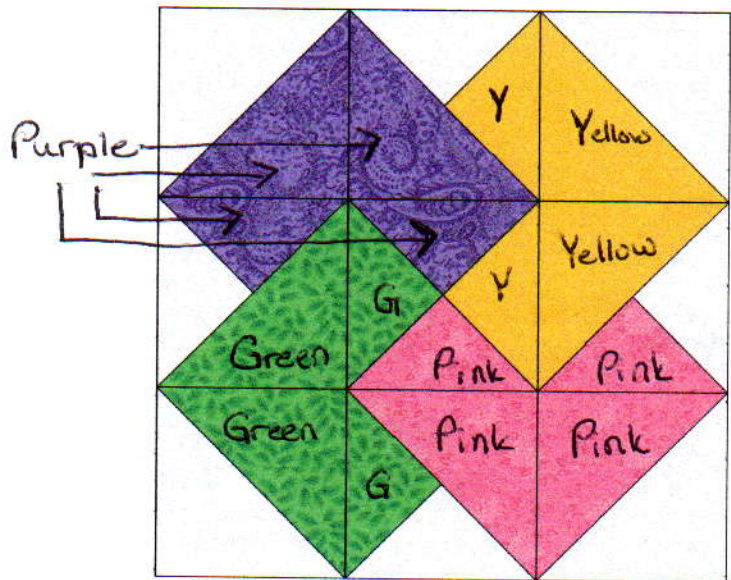
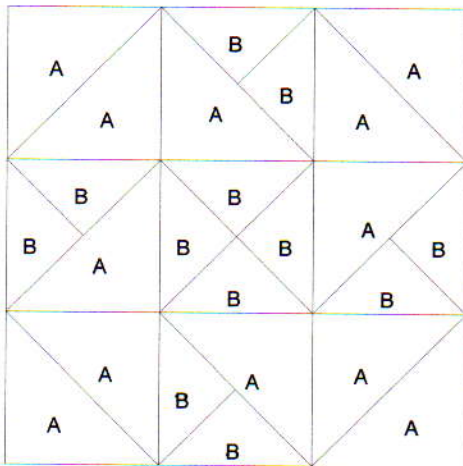


Block Lotto Card Trick

Please return completed block at the May meeting



For this block please use 1930's prints in purple, yellow, pink and green and for the background use an antique white solid.

Cutting:

From the 4 different 30's prints	1 - 4 7/8" square - cut once on the diagonal
	1 - 5 1/4" square - cut twice on the diagonal
From the white	2 - 4 7/8" squares - cut once on the diagonal
From the red	1 - 5 1/4" square - cut twice on the diagonal

Assembly:

- Using 4 large white triangles and 1 of each of the 4 colors of print large triangles, make 4 white/print half square triangles
- Using 4 small white triangles and 1 of each of the 4 colors of small print triangles, stitch together along a short side to make a larger triangle. White triangle should be to the left. See block layout.
- Using the 4 triangles made above, and following the block layout for color placement, add a large print triangle to make a 4 1/2" square.
- Using one each of the smaller print triangles, and following the block layout for color placement, make one hourglass block for center square.
- Lay out your nine units as shown in the diagram
- Piece as you would any 9 patch block
- Your block should measure 12 1/2" square
