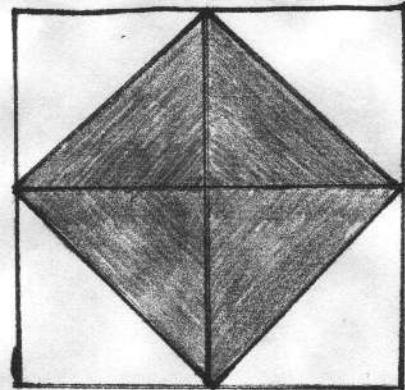


Beaver Valley Piecemakers
Mystery Quilt
December 3, 2008

This month, you will make 2 - 6 1/2" Square in a Square Blocks, 2-- 6 1/2" Pinwheel Blocks, and 8 - 5 1/2" Half Square Triangles.

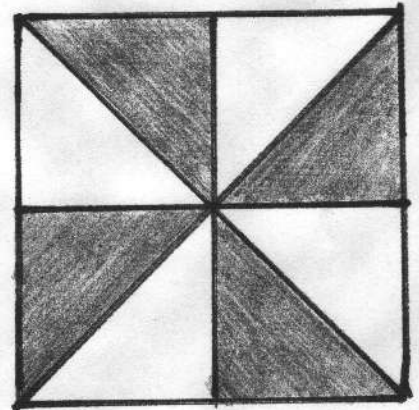
Square in a Square (2)

From the 3 1/2" half square triangles made in November, select 8 to make 2 - 6 1/2" blocks. Referring to the illustration, sew the squares together in pairs. Press the seam allowances in opposite directions. Join 2 pairs together to make the square in a square block.



Pinwheel Blocks (2)

From the 3 1/2" half square triangles made in November, Select 8 to make 2- 6 1/2" blocks. Referring to the illustration, sew the squares together in pairs. Press seams in opposite directions. Then join 2 pairs to make the pinwheel block.



These blocks should measure 6 1/2" including the seam allowances.

5 1/2" Half Square Triangles (8)

Select 8 Dark and 8 Light 5 1/2" squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light squares. Place a marked light square atop a dark square right sides together. Sew on the drawn line. Trim away the excess fabric on one side of the sewn line. Press open with seam allowances toward the dark print. Repeat to make 8. Label and set aside for later use.
