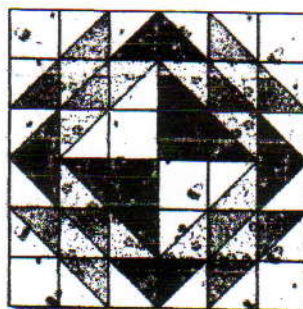


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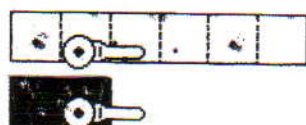


Corn and Beans

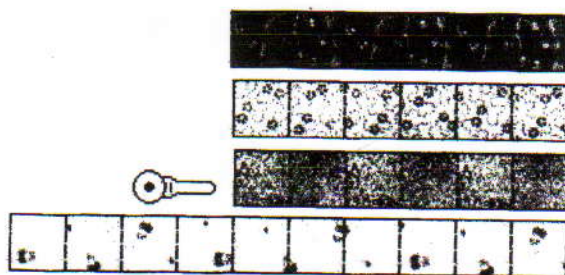
It's a 12" block!



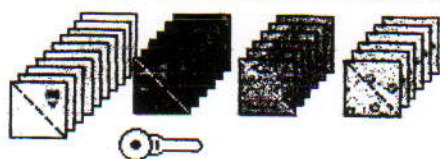
** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



Let's mark and then cut the 2-1/2" x 15" Color 1 strip first, into six 2-1/2" squares...then mark and cut the Color 2 2-1/2" x 5" strip into two 2-1/2" squares...



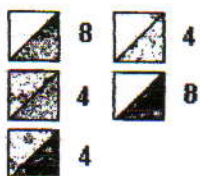
Next, mark and cut all the 2-7/8" strips into 2-7/8" squares. Colors 2, 3 and 4 will give you six 2-7/8" squares each. Color 1 will give you ten...



Then further cut each of these 2-7/8" squares once on the diagonals...



You will be sewing your small triangles made in the previous step, using the standard 1/4" seams...and always pressing the seam allowances towards the darker fabrics...

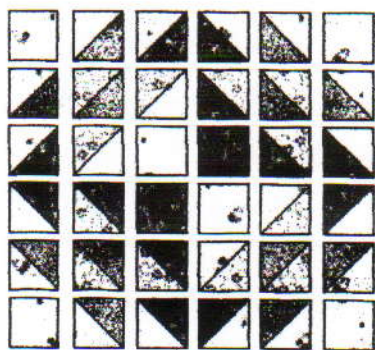


..Making the number of combination half squares that you see in the illustration on the left. Trim each to 2-1/2" if needed...

...on to Page 2!

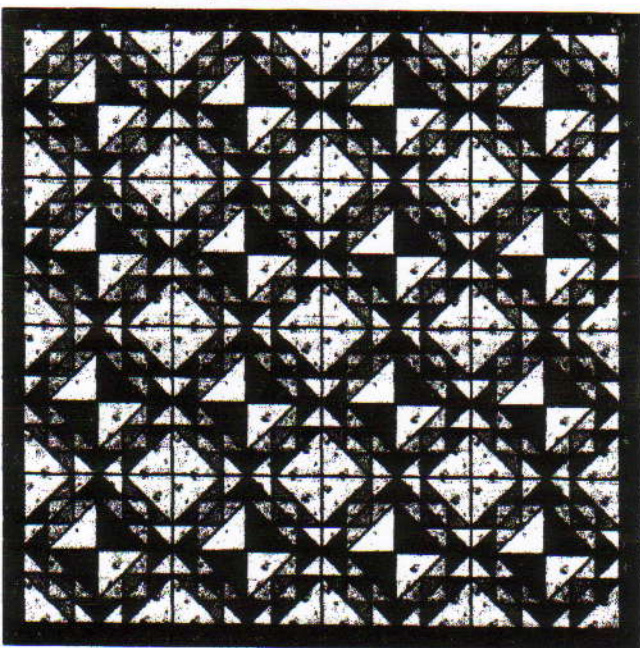


Corn and Beans - Page 2



And then...easy as pie...sew them together, again using scant 1/4" seams...following the diagram to the left for placement of each!!

And THAT'S IT!...another block that LOOKED tricky...but really is quite straight forward piecing!



Either way...it's a great little Block...and have fun with it!!

**** Supplies List ****



Color 1 strip

Color 1 needs: one 2-1/2" x 15" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 28-3/4"



Color 2 strip

Color 2 needs: one 2-1/2" x 5" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 17-1/4"



Color 3 Color 3 needs: one 2-7/8" x 17-1/4" strip



Color 4 Color 4 needs: one 2-7/8" x 17-1/4" strip
