

**PINEAPPLE PLUS TABLE RUNNER - FOUR SQUARES, BORDER, BINDING AND BATTING. Kit with everything except thread**

\$23.00 each

FOR CLASS →

seam ripper  
SCISSORS  
ROTARY CUTTER  
18x24 or 16x20 rotary mat  
pins & pencil or pen

To create your own kit you will need:

5/8 yard neutral or plainer fabric.

If all the pineapples are the same (contrast fabric to your neutral) INCLUDING borders and binding 1 1/4 yards.

Batting 20" x 48"

Neutral thread

If two colors are used in pineapples 3/8 yard EACH.

Plus 3/4 yard border and binding.

Batting approx. 20" x 48" (we use half loft so runner is flat and doesn't tip a glass.)

Neutral thread

If you would like the center of the pineapple different than the rest of the fabrics, get 1/8 yard of what you would like for the center.

I will be happy to cut kits complete except for thread (bring neutral) for \$23.00 each.

Pick from the following subjects: fall, Christmas, or name a color like blue and I will create a kit.

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**Pineapple Plumes Quilt (page 3)**

Blue Batik - 1 1/4 yards  
Pink - 1 yard  
Turquoise - 3/4 yard  
Cream - 1 yard  
Dark cream - 1/4 yard (centre blocks fabric)

**Sew Simple Pineapple Plus by Karin Hellaby**

**Pineapple Jazz Quilt (backcover)**

Light batiks - 1/2 yard from each of two fabrics  
Gold - 1/2 yard  
Black - 1/2 yard  
Tan/red - 1 yard also used in binding  
Grey - 3/4 yard  
Border - 3/4 yard

**Bubble Gum Quilt (page 5)**

Fabric required : One Layer Cake (approx. 36 10" squares) and 1 1/2 yards navy blue fabric.  
Make 12 pineapple blocks using the four triangle technique on page 10 in Pineapple Plus by Karin Hellaby  
Stitch the 12 blocks together as shown in the quilt photograph with a 1/2" seam.

## SUPPLY LIST FOR RETREAT KNITTING CLASS

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One skein of light colored *worsted weight yarn* such as Vanna's Choice with size 10 knitting needles or Wool-ease with size 9 knitting needles. If you want a very long scarf (as in 72 inches) you will need two skeins. Both yarns are readily available but note that the Wool-ease is indeed washable wool so if you have a wool allergy you should select Vanna's Choice. If you are just using this as a refresher class and you also have the next size up needles (10 and 11) bring them along. If you have another brand worsted wool (there are many) feel free to use that. A light color is easier to work on. This is not the place for the fuzzy yarns as they are tricky to use.

If you have these items please bring them along but *don't go out and purchase* items until you know you will really want to pursue this.

- Yarn needle
- crochet hook (H, I or J will be fine) small scissors
- markers
- little stoppers for the end of the needles (a wine cork works fine)

- Covering basic stitches
- Reading a label
- Casting on and off
- Rescue techniques
- Getting started on knitting a scarf
