## **Square In A Square With Cornerstones**

Finished quilt measures 31 ½" X 39"

## **Supplies:**

¼ yd of print fabric for center square
¾ yd of various colored fabrics for outside squares
1/8 yd of print fabric for corner stones-you will need 30 cornerstones
1/2 yd background fabric for sashing
10 inches of fabric of your choice for binding

## **Directions:**

- 1. For center squares cut 20 4" X 4" squares
- 2. For outer squares cut 2" strips X WOF then sub cut into two 2" X 4-inch strips and two 2" X 7.0" strips for each square.
- 3. Sew a 4" X 2" strip of outer square fabric to 2 sides of the 4" squares. Press seam toward the outside. Then sew a 7.0" X 2" strip to the top and bottom of the unit to form a 7" square. Square up your squares.
- 4. Sew a 7.0" strip of background fabric to the right side of each of the squares and press seam toward the outside. Additionally, sew a 2" X7" strip to 5 of the squares that will be the first block of each of the rows. Sew 20 corner stones to each of the 7" X 2" background strips. The first block of each row will have an additional corner stone sewn to each end. Lay out your blocks to your desired pattern.
- 5. Sew the cornerstone/sashing strips to the top of each of the blocks. (You will also sew four cornerstone/sashing strips to the bottom of the four blocks at the bottom of the quilt).
- 6. Sew all of the blocks together to form five rows and then sew the rows together to finish the quilt top. Quilt as desired and bind.
