

Supply List:

Pin Cushion

You need batting cut in 2" widths. I think about 45" long. Doesn't have to be 1 piece. A lid to put it in, mason jar size works well. Lace to put around it. A 3" square of fabric for walnut shells for the needle

sharpener. Needle and thread. Scissors. Kathy will bring glue and walnuts.

Do you have an old quilt that you really don't know anything about, or a bran new quilt that you have made and want to share with others the journey that you took while making his quilt? Or maybe you have an heirloom quilt and the history and information about the maker should be recorded for future generation. Having a quilt documented by the trained quilt documentation staff is something you should consider.

January 9th and 10th will be a documentation at the Vicary Mansion. Appointments are scheduled on a ½ hour rotation. Eight pages of information will be completedmin regards to the type of quilt, name and condition of the quilt, as well as the maker of the quilt. Thisinformation is not only kept in the archives of the Vicary Mansion, but is entered into an international data base-www.Quiltindex.org. There is data from all over the world on this site that anyone can have access to.
