## **One Special Star**



## Supplies and Cutting:

Green: Four 3 ½" squares and four rectangles 3 ½" X 6 ½" Red: Two 4" squares and four 3 ½" squares Cream: Two 4" squares and four 3 ½" squares

**Step 1:** Place the 4" cream squares and 4" red squares right sides together. Draw a line diagonally down the center of the cream squares and sew ¼" on each side of the line, then cut on the center line. Press the HST's open and trim to 3 ½" square.



**Step 2:** Sew the squares into pairs and then sew the pairs together to make the pinwheel center for the block.



**Step 3:** Place a  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " cream square right sides together on the left side of the green rectangle. Draw a line diagonally, pin and stitch on the line. Trim off extra fabric to leave a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam

allowance and press open.



**Step 4:** Sew a red 3 ½" square to the right side of the rectangle and draw a diagonal line through the center as shown. Pin and sew on the line. Trim to ¼" seam allowance and press open. Make 4 of these flying geese units.



**Step 5:** Sew 2 of the flying geese units to oposite sides of the pinwheel square. Sew a green 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each end of the 2 remaining flying geese units, and then sew onto block. Sew the three rows together. This makes a 12.5 inch unfinished block.
