

## WEATHER VANE



Makes a 12.5" unfinished block

### Supplies:

#### Background Fabric (white):

- A: Cut twelve 2 ½" X 2 ½" squares
- B: Cut one 6 ½" x 6 ½" square

### Four Different Prints:

- C: (Light print) Cut four 4 ½" X 4 ½" squares
- D: (Dark print) Cut four 4 ½" X 4 ½" squares
- E: (Medium print) Cut one 6 ½" X 6 ½" square
- F: (Light or Medium print): Cut one 4 ½" X 4 ½" square

### Instructions:

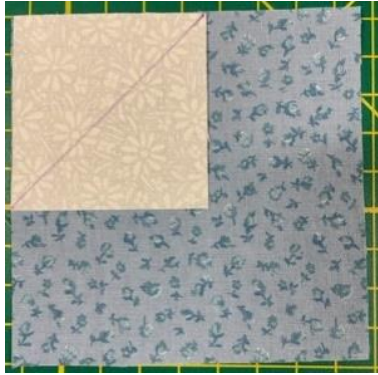
Draw a diagonal line across both diagonals on the wrong side of the "B" square. Next place a "B" square right side down onto an "E" square. (LEFT PICTURE) Sew a scant ¼" seam on both sides of the marked diagonal lines. Then cut the square into eighths as shown. To do this cut in half vertically and horizontally, then cut diagonally along both drawn lines. Press toward the darker fabric and then trim the eight half square triangles to 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares. (RIGHT PICTURE)



Lay out and then assemble four corner sections using an "A" square, two half square triangles, and a "C" square. Make four and trim to 4 ½" X 4 ½". **\*Be careful with placement of squares for each corner.**



Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the wrong side of the remaining "A" squares. Place an "A" square on the top left corner of the "D" square. Sew along the drawn line, then trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the stitch line and press toward the darker fabric. (LEFT PICTURE) Sew a second "A" square to the top right corner using the same method. Make 4 of these and trim to  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". (RIGHT PICTURE)



Assemble the block as shown.
