

# Hole in the Barn Door

Circa 1935

## Supplies:



Color 1

Color 1 needs: one 4" X 8" strip AND one 1-1/2" X 26 1/2" strip AND one 6 1/2" square



Color 2

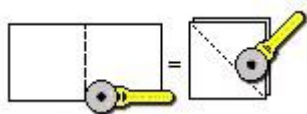
Color 2 needs: one 4" X 8" strip AND one 2 1/2" X 26 1/2" strip



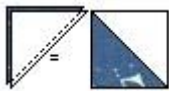
## Preparation and Sewing:



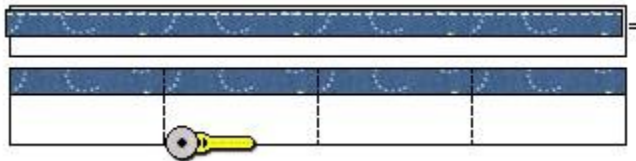
- Begin by marking and cutting the Color 1 4" X 8" strip into two 4" squares. Stack them and cut once on the diagonal to make four half square triangles.



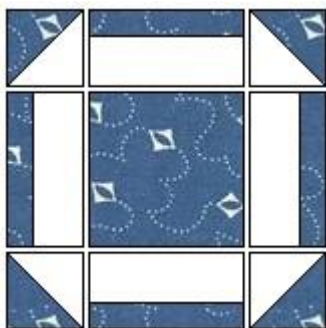
- Mark and cut the color 2 4" X 8" strip into two 4" squares. Stack them and cut once on the diagonal to make four half square triangles.



- Sew a Color 1 and a Color 2 half square triangle together using a scant 1/4" seam. Press seams toward the darkest side and then trim the block to measure 3-1/2". Make four units like this.



- Sew the Color 1 1 1/2" X 26 1/2" strip and the Color 2 2 1/2" X 26 1/2" strips together lengthwise using a scant 1/4" seam. Press the seam toward the darker fabric and then cut into 6 1/2 inch sections.



- Piece the block together as shown. Make three rows using the Color 1 6 1/2" square for the center of the block. Press seams in alternate directions by row and then sew the rows together.
