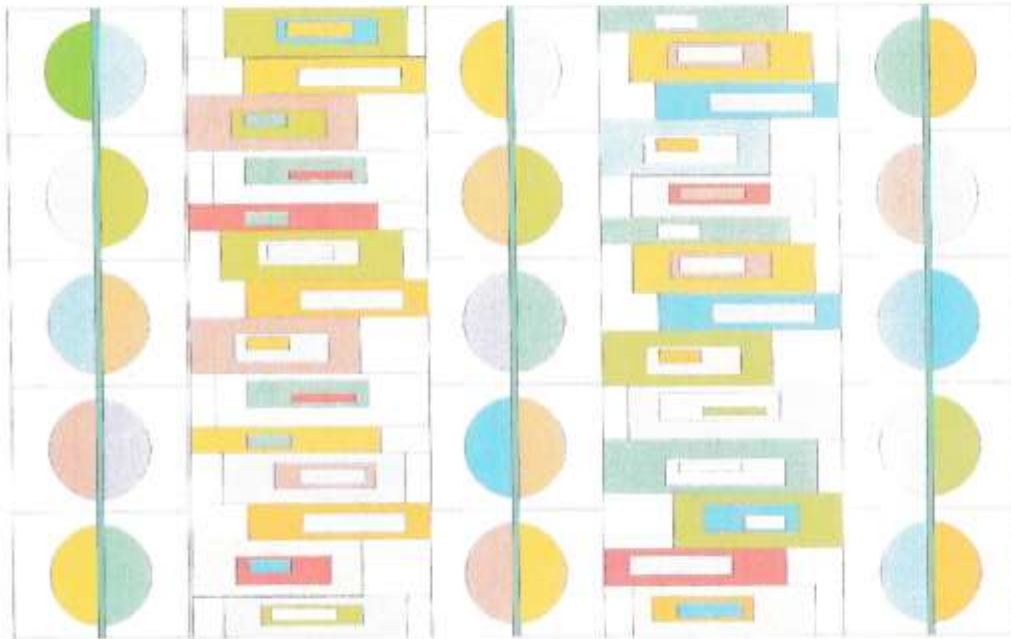


MODERN MYSTERY QUILT INSTALLMENT #6

Assembling the Quilt

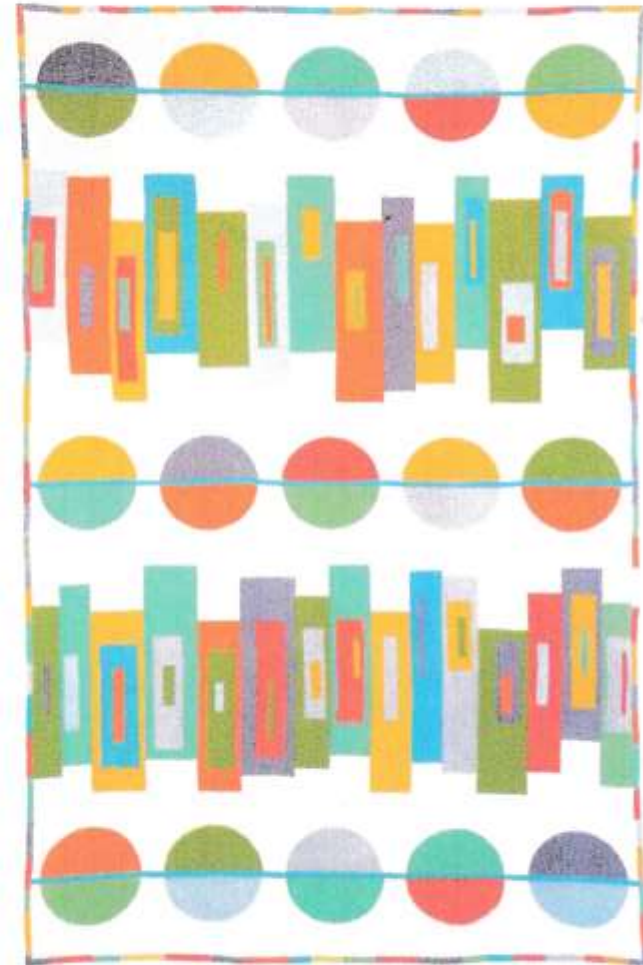
1. Sew together the 3 columns of circles and two columns of stacks as shown. Press seams open.



2. Sew together two 54"×42" lengths of fabric along the selvage to make the backing.
3. Layer top, batting and backing.
4. Baste the layers together.
5. Quilt. We used a freehand wave pattern horizontally & vertically.
6. Join the seven 40" strips of assorted colors (from part 4) end-to-end, making a strip approximately 280" long. This will be a pieced binding.



6. Bind using your preferred binding method. If you regularly use a narrower binding strip, cut the pieced binding to size.
