

Mini Bow Ties



Supplies: four color fabrics and a background fabric (white/off white)



Color 1

Color 1 bow tie needs one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X 7" strip and one 2" X 4" strip



Color 2

Color 2 bow tie needs one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X 7" strip and one 2" X 4" strip



Color 3

Color 3 bow tie needs one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X 7" strip and one 2" X 4" strip



Color 4

Color 4 bow tie needs one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X 7" strip and one 2" X 4" strip

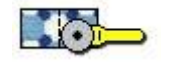


Color 5

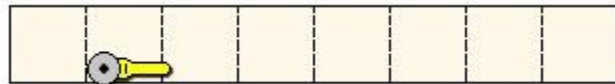
Color 5 (background fabric) needs one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X $28\frac{1}{2}$ " strip



First cut the color 1 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X 7" strip into two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Repeat this step for colors 2, 3, and 4.



Next, cut the color 1 2" X 4" strip into two 2" squares. Repeat for colors 2, 3, and 4.



Then cut the color 5 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X $28\frac{1}{2}$ " strip into eight $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares



Now, with right sides together, place a small color one square on top of a color 5 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square with edges lined up with one corner of the Color 5 square. On the back of the top of the small square draw a light diagonal line and sew along this marked

line. Cut off the excess seam allowance and press towards the darker fabric. Make two units like this for Colors 1, 2, 3, and 4. Using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, piece the bow ties together. Sew the four $6\frac{1}{2}$ " bow tie units together as a four patch block.
