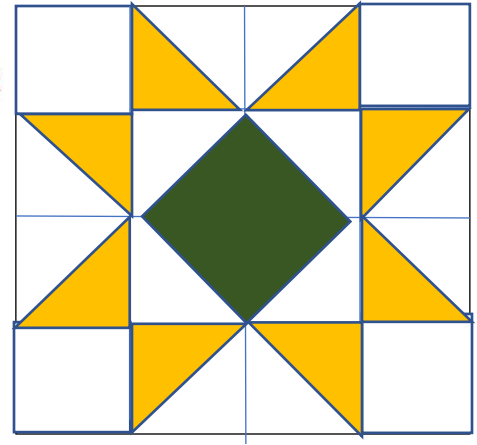





**Beaver Valley Piecemakers

to return at January 2022**

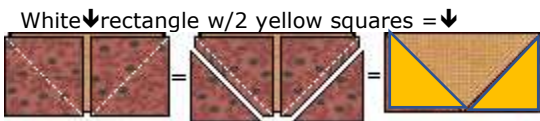
*Star of Virginia*  
This makes a 12" block!



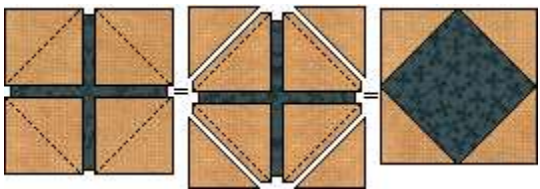
**\*\* Supplies List \*\***

-  Color 1 (Yellow) needs: eight 3½" squares
-  Color 2 (Dark Green print) needs: one 6½" square
-  Color 3 (White) needs: eight 3½" squares AND  
four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

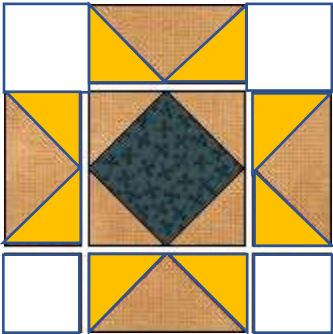
Be aware that some of the colors shown in the sewing examples are not the actual colors of the Block Lotto Block. Follow the color design of the colors on the block in the upper right and on the supplies list.



To make a side unit, place a **Yellow** Color 1 square right sides together atop a White Color 3 rectangle, with outer edges aligned. On the back of the top square lightly mark the diagonal. Sew one thread away from this diagonal marking, on the yellow side. Cut off the excess seam allowance. Press the remainder towards the corner. Repeat this with another **Yellow** Color 1 square on the other end of the rectangle. Make four of these.



In the same manner as in the step above, sew Color 3 squares to the four corners of the **Green** Color 2, 6½" square to make the block's center unit.



Lay out all units as shown at left. Sew three horizontal rows, pressing the top and bottom row seams to the outside, and the middle row seam to the center. Sew the rows together that's all there is to this one!

(All flying geese are white w/yellow)
