

WREATH BLOCK



Supplies and Cutting Instructions:

Fabric #1: Cream
One 6 1/2" square
Two 3" squares
Four 2 1/2" squares
Two 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" pieces

Fabric #2: Green
One 2 1/2" X 10 1/2" piece
Two 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" pieces
One 3" square
Two 2 1/2" squares

Fabric #3: Red
One 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" piece
One 3" square
Three 2 1/2" squares

Step#1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of two 2 1/2" green and two 2 1/2" red squares. Lay out the squares on the corners of the 6 1/2" cream square. Sew on each marked line and then trim 1/4" past the line and press.



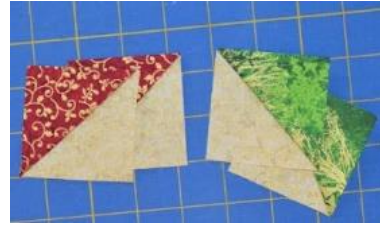
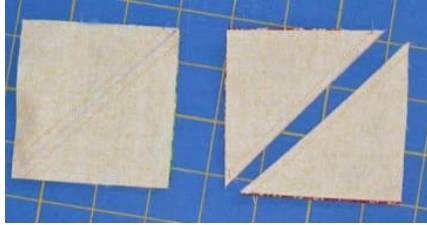
Step #2: Sew 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" green pieces to the left and right sides.



Step #3: Draw a line on the wrong side of two 2 1/2" cream squares. Lay the square on both ends of the 2 1/2" X 10 1/2" green piece. Sew on the drawn lines and trim seam allowance to 1/4" and press.



Step #4: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the two 3" cream squares. Layer the marked squares wrong sides together with 3" green and red squares. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the marked lines. Cut on the lines and press the half-square triangles open.



Step #5: Lay out the units from Steps 2 and 3, the HST's, two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " cream squares, one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " red square, and one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $6\frac{1}{2}$ " red piece. Sew the pieces in the bottom two rows together to create rows, then join the rows.



Step #6: Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X $12\frac{1}{2}$ " cream pieces to the left and right sides to complete the block.
