## Star Block \#2



## Supplies:

1. Cream Fabric: Cut four -4 " squares
2. Red Fabric: Cut two- $4^{\prime \prime}$ squares and two $-3 \frac{112 \prime \prime}{\prime \prime}$ squares
3. Green Fabric: Cut two- 4 " squares and two $-31 / 2 \prime$ squares
4. Multi-Print: Cut four- 4 " squares

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the WRONG side of the four 4" cream squares and one each 4" green and red square. Pair two cream squares with the unmarked multicolor squares, and one each with the remaining unmarked red and green square.


Step 2: Stitch $1 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " on either side of the drawn line and cut on the drawn line. Press both units open.


Step 3: Trim HST's to measure $31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square. You will have two red/multi, two green/multi, two red/cream, two green/cream and four cream/multi HST's.


Step 4: Lay out the HST's with the two $31 / 2$ " red squares and two $31 / 2$ green squares as shown. Then sew the units into rows, alternating the pressing direction in each row. Sew the rows together to complete the block.
