

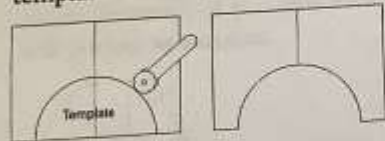
MODERN MYSTERY QUILT INSTALLMENT #2

Making the Blocks (Continued)

1. From one fabric, cut 15 strips $1" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$. Set aside for later. Do not use this fabric in step 5.
2. From the field fabric, cut 30 pieces $7\frac{1}{4}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$.
3. Fold each of the 30 rectangles in half. Finger crease then unfold.



4. Transfer template A to template plastic or heavy paper. Align bottom edge of template with bottom edge of rectangle, aligning the center line with the fold. Cut along curved edge of template. You'll no longer need this semicircle.



5. Transfer template B to template plastic or heavy paper. Using the template as your guide, cut 30 semicircles from colored fabrics other than the one used in step 1.



6. Select a colored B semicircle and a field A piece. Fold the each in half and finger-crease to mark their centers.
