

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCK #1



Unfinished block measures $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " square

Cutting:

Red: Cut four 4" squares

Blue: Cut four 4" squares

White: Cut eight 4" squares

Step #1:

Draw a diagonal line on the back side of each white square. Place the white squares on top of the four red squares and the four blue squares right sides together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the center line and then cut apart on the middle line.



Step #2:

Press towards the dark fabric and then trim the squares to measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. You will have 16 squares.



Step #3:

Lay out the half square triangles as shown, sew together into four rows and then sew the rows together.
