# TREE BLOCK 12 ½" square unfinished block



### **Supplies and Cutting:**

#### From the cream or cream print cut:

Two 2-½" X 5-1/2" pieces Two 2-½" X 4-½" pieces Two 2-½ X 3-½" pieces Twelve 2-½" X 2-½" squares

## From the green or green print #2 cut:

One 2 -½" X 6- ½" piece One 2- ½" X 10 -½" piece

Two 2-1/2" X 1-1/2" pieces

#### From the green or green print #1 cut:

One 2- ½" X 4- ½" piece One 2- ½" X 8- ½" piece One 2 – ½" X 12- ½" piece

## From the brown or brown print cut:

One 2 -1/2" square

**Step 1:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 10 2 - ½" squares.

**Step 2:** Layer the marked squares right sides together on both ends of the green print pieces as shown.



**Step 3:** For the top green print #1 piece, stitch on the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼" and press open. Position the second marked square as shown; sew, trim and press.



**Step 4:** Add the remaining marked squares in the same way.



**Step 5:** Lay out the cream spacer pieces as shown below. The  $2-\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $4-\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces are on the top row,  $2-\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $3-\frac{1}{2}$ " in the second row,  $2-\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in the third row, and  $1-\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $2-\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces in the fourth row. Sew the pieces into rows.



**Step 6:** To make the trunk, lay out the two  $2-\frac{1}{2}$ " X 5-  $\frac{1}{2}$ " cream pieces with the 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " brown/brown print square. Sew the pieces together.



**Step 7:** Join the five tree rows and one trunk row together.
