## NOTICE: Reminder for long-time members, and news that newer members may not be aware of...

The "Member-Only" page on the website is, as it says, only available to members of Beaver Valley Piecemakers. If you haven't signed in to the member-only page on the website, please do so. Minutes from the meetings are available here, as well as the pictorial member directory. This directory is immensely helpful in learning people's names and faces. With almost 100 members, using the directory is the easiest way to become familiar with everyone. Please make use of this resource, along with everything else on the website, to help you become an active, involved member of the guild.

To sign in, on the Home Page, locate the "Members Only" button next to the Dove. Click on the button and you'll be taken to the sign-in page. Make sure you have clicked to "Sign UP", not "Sign IN". Fill in the form and submit it, and Vivian will be notified that you're requesting access. You will be approved as quickly as possible. (Sometimes it's a minute, sometimes it's day, but it depends on when she is made aware of the request.) If you're in a hurry, send Vivian a text to let her know, and she'll usually get right on it. (Barring any unforeseen circumstances.) You'll be notified as soon as you're approved, at which time you can again go to the member only page, then click to "Sign IN", not "Sign Up."
