

# Shoofly



## Supplies:



Color 1

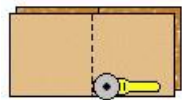
Color 1 (background fabric): one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " X 18" strip AND one 5" X 10" strip



Color 2

Color 2 (focus fabric): one 5" X 10" strip AND one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square

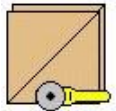
## Preparation and Sewing:



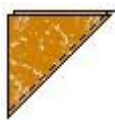
Cut each of the 5" X 10" strips into two 5" squares



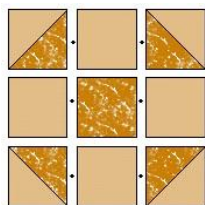
Next cut the 5" squares on the diagonal...be careful not to stretch the fabric!



You will then cut the color 1  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " X 18" strip into four  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares



Sew four color 1 triangles to four color 2 triangles with right sides together along the diagonals using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Be careful to not stretch the fabrics. Press seams toward the darkest fabric. Trim the blocks to measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.



Lay out your units as shown. Sew three horizontal rows pressing the top and bottom row seams toward the outside and the middle row seam towards the center. Join the three rows together.
