The Everything and More Bag
from Missouri Star Quilt Company

Supplies:

Fabrics:

- 1 panel or 1 yard fabric (lining)
- 1 yard fabric for main body and pockets
- 1 yard for straps and pocket lining

Batting:

- Runner size or 1 piece 25" x 42".
- 1-1/2" strips for straps - approximately 80"

Zippers:

- 2 - 14" non-metal zippers

Thread

Quilting Clips, Pins, Scissors

Iron, Ironing Board

Rotary Cutter, Ruler, Cutting Mat
