## JUNE DINNER – Louise Grant

To those who have paid registrations for the BVPM Quilt Guild June 2nd Dinner at The Fez:

Due to inadequate number of registrations, we have had to make the decision to cancel the planned June 2nd dinner at The Fez. We have only 31 registered to attend and we needed at least 50. The Guild was willing to host the dinner if we had gotten 45 registrations but after making personal calls to all those listed in our Directory, we were not able to make the number financially feasible.

This is certainly understandable given all the Covid issues we have dealt with over the last 16 months, but even with relaxed guidelines there simply was not enough to host the event.

Our last dinner held in 2019 attracted 64 attendees so when planning for 2020 we felt comfortable, at the time, thinking we would attract 50 or more, which is a minimum requirement for evening events at The Fez. When forced to cancel/postpone in 2020 we were permitted to carry the contract forward to 2021.

The Fez is willing to carry our \$200 deposit forward through 2022 should we wish to schedule something else at another time. Perhaps a luncheon, which does not carry the minimum of 50 may be considered. As Host Committee chair, I am open to suggestions.

If you haven't done so yet, please advise how you wish to get your \$26 checks back. I'm happy to mail them, or I can shred them if you prefer. Please reply to me only and advise your preference.

I'm sorry for any inconvenience. I was so hoping we could have an enjoyable evening. Perhaps another time!
