

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCK #2



Unfinished block measures 12 ½" square

Cutting:

Red: Cut two 4" squares

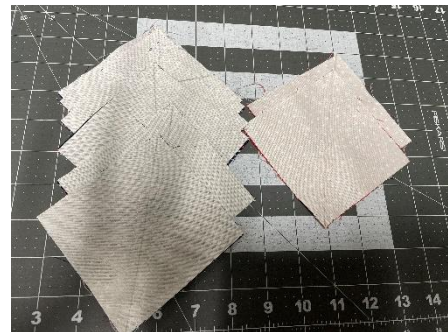
White: Cut eight 4" squares

Blue: Cut six 4" squares



Step #1:

Place a white square on top of each of the red and blue squares, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the back side of each white square. Sew ¼" on each side of the drawn line and then cut apart on the middle line.



Step #2:

Press towards the dark fabric and then trim the squares to measure 3 ½" square. You will have 16 3-1/2" squares.

Step #3:

Lay out the half square triangles as shown. Sew together into four rows and then sew the rows together to form the block.
