

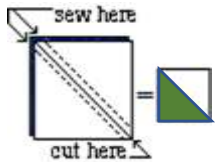


The “Original” Ribbon Star

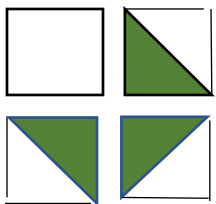
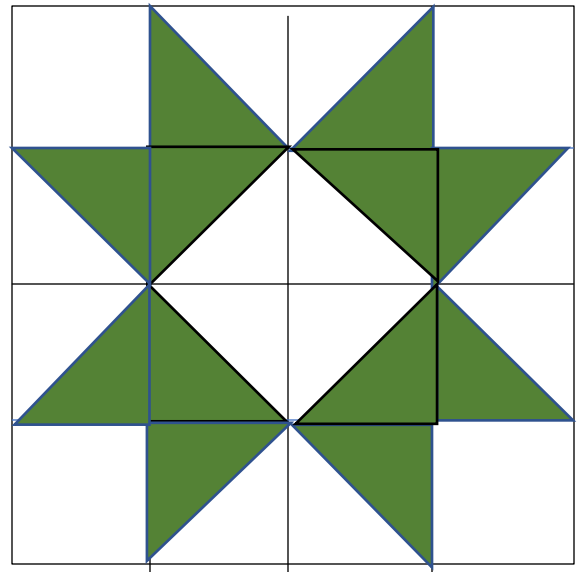
This is the one that first appeared in the Ladies Art Company publication
Beaver Valley Piecemakers Block Lotto
 May '22 – to return Sept. '22

 Green – Six 3-7/8” squares

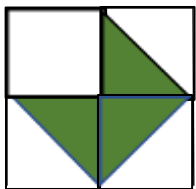
 White – Four 3 1/2” squares; Six 3-7/8” squares



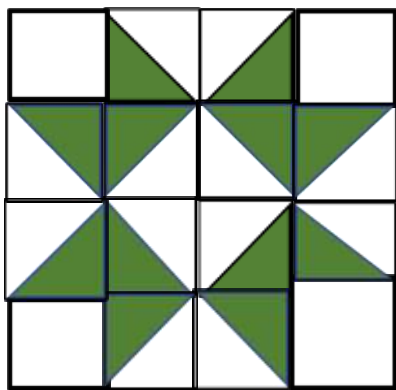
Draw a diagonal line on six 3-7/8” squares.
 Place green and white 3-7/8” squares right sides
 together. Sew a scant quarter-inch away
 from both sides of the diagonal line. Cut on the
 center line. Press to the green side.



Lay out one Light/White 3 1/2” square and three of the Green/White HSTs. Sew the four blocks
 Together as you would a basic 4-Patch. Repeat with the remaining three 4-Patch units.



The patches now get sewn together just like a basic 4-Patch block. Sew the
 patches into two rows and press the seam allowances away from the green.
 Make three more 4-Patch blocks the same as shown.



Now take these four patches and sew the units together again like a
 Basic 4-Patch. This completes your block! Congratulations!! You did it!
