### Beaver Valley Piecemakers

The Beaver Valley Piecemakers was founded in 1983. Our goals are to encourage and advance the knowledge and understanding of all aspects of quilt making while promoting good fellowship through sharing the art and finished products of quilting.

We have made many quilts over the years that have been donated to Children and Youth Services of Beaver County, the Medical Center, the Women's Center of Beaver County and Project Linus. A special group of wall hangings was made for the children of McGuire Home and can be viewed at the facility. Various kinds of hats were made and donated to the American Cancer Society. Since 2008 we have participated in "Quilts of Valor", a nationwide project whose mission is to *cover* all servicemen and veterans touched by war, honoring those who have served their country. We've awarded approximately 200 quilts for QOV, and we continue to make these special quilts for our veterans. We've made and donated more than 200 pillowcases for the Mars Home for Youth facility and made over 250 scarves for the Cancer Center and "Reading Pillows". Last year we made microwaveable bowl cozies for Meals on Wheels and this year are making more cozies and pet beds for the Humane Society, as well as shoulder bags for breast cancer patients.

Quilters of all levels of expertise are invited to attend our meetings and to join our guild. We meet the first Wednesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. at Pathways Church, 239 Braun Rd. Beaver Falls, PA. Dues are \$20 per year.

## Meet the Quilt Show Judge Linda McCuean

Linda McCuean has been making quilts for over 45 years. Linda is a self taught quilter, building on her extensive background in garment sewing. When the longarm quilting machines began to gain popularity in the 1990's, Linda switched from hand quilting to machine quilting and still does both! Linda's quilts have been published in various magazines, books, and calendars, and her Masterpiece quilt, Bella, was seen on the Today Show in January 2007 when it was the winner of the \$100,000 Quilting Challenge.

Linda became NQA certified as a quilt judge in 2004. She has traveled all over Pennsylvania and New Jersey, and to further destinations in New Hampshire, Illinois, Minnesota, Florida, Georgia, Texas, Arizona, and the Pacific Northwest to judge quilt shows and enjoy the company of the quilters she meets along the way.

#### Judging

A critique form is used for the judging of each quilt and is given to the quilter when the quilt is returned to them at the end of the show. This form will enable each quilter to benefit from the judge's comments, their insights, and encouragements. The comments help us to learn what we are doing well and what aspects of quilt-making that we can improve upon. Each quilt is judged for visual impact—the use of color and design and workmanship—construction, quilting and finishing.

If you have never before entered a quilt, we encourage you to enter a quilt into our show next year. You do not have to be a member of our guild to enter a quilt.
